How to get an education in Canada, the Canadian education system is significantly different from the one to which residents of Russia, Ukraine, Belarus and other former Soviet republics are accustomed, so often the desire to go to study in Canada is divided into elementary questions - where to start? How to choose a Canadian educational institution? How to get permission to study in Canada so that it is given, etc. Therefore, we decided to start from the beginning and progressively explain how to go to study in Canada.

How to go to study in Canada. 7 smart steps.

1. Decide on learning goals. Why did you need to get an education in Canada? If the goal is immigration to Canada through education, it makes sense to study immigration programs in more detail in order to understand their requirements and, accordingly, to understand the requirements for the formation that you need to get. If the goal is only in the training itself, which should continue to help you build a career, then you are more free in the choice of the program and the place of study.

2. Evaluate your resources and opportunities. In most cases, training in Canada costs money. And even if you suddenly succeed in getting a scholarship or grant, then the cost of accommodation will remain. Do you have enough financial resources? You will need to prove the Canadian immigration service that you already have all the necessary funds for payment of training (the entire program, and not one semester) and living in the country during the training period, otherwise the chance of failure in a visa will be very large. An exception is perhaps that very young students who sponsor parents. In this case, parents can be enough to show funds for the year of study and accommodation and revenues that will allow them to pay for all further years.

Moreover, the reality is such that far from every program you will be given a visa. The immigration officer should not have doubts that this training really needs and makes sense for further career. It is logical when the bachelor goes to learn to the master, for example. But the doctor of science, which goes to learn from college, causes certain suspicions. Therefore, not everyone can choose the cheapest version of education.

And one more important thing is your own level of English or French. Objectively appreciate your linguistic skills. It is better to do this using international language tests of type IELTS and TEF (for French). Language requirements of Canadian educational institutions usually range from 6 to 7.5 points in IELTS ACADEMIC format. If you do not dial even 6, then you should first pull the tongue.

3. Select the learning program, specialty and place. Evaluate the existing education, work experience and compare them with learning goals and their capabilities. If you want to immigrate to Canada, then good chances give a two-year program. But in order to enroll on a two-year Master's

program, for example, you must have a bachelor's degree. The specialty and place of training also need to be chosen, having studied provincial immigration programs (PNP), which often offer opportunities for obtaining residence permits to graduates of their universities in certain areas (for example, masters, doctors of science, owners of qualifying certificates) and / or certain specialties, for which the province is experiencing a lack of labor.

As mentioned above, the selected program should not reduce your chances of obtaining a work permit (Study Permit). Even if you are going to learn to further immigrate, then the main goal of the trip, which you will indicate to the Canadian immigration service, is a study. And the immigration officer should not doubt this goal, wondering why the successful owner of his own business suddenly needed training in plumbing.

4. Select an educational institution. When you have already decided on the program and specialty (for example, Master in the field of human resource management), it remains to find an educational institution in the selected province. Here you can use different rates of educational institutions, but keep in mind that all colleges and universities of Canada adhere to a strict educational standard. Here, anywhere and no one draws estimates just like that, not "sell" diplomas. Here, a specialist is not refusing to work only because he has a diploma of some provincial university, and not the high-tech capital. Therefore, once again think about your goals, and decide whether it makes sense to overpay for the name.

5. Apply for admission to the selected educational institution. In Canada, educational institutions have the right to establish the criteria for selecting applicants, so there are no general rules and generally accepted exams. Check the requirements on the site of a particular institution or contact its representative. At this stage, many are afraid of passing the passage of the seven CHA circles we are familiar with when some full-time exams are required, the results of the exam, etc., but in Canada, the process of admission to the school is much easier. Most often, it comes down to the collection of necessary documents, their translation, confirmation of language skills and sending documents to the university. Sometimes you may require remote surrender of international exams, such as GMAT.

Language requirements Each educational institution also establishes independently. Moreover, often in one university can be their requirements for each program, so carefully study them. Most likely, you will need to provide the results of one of the international tests that will confirm your compliance with the program's linguistic requirements. The most common is IELTS, TOEFL, MELAB, Ciel to confirm the English level and TEF for French.

6. Obtaining permission to study. If you have successfully entered the program to a Canadian educational institution and received a letter of enrollment (Letter of Acceptance), then it is time to start the process of obtaining all the necessary documents to move to Canada for training. In the overwhelming majority, for training in Canada you will need not only a visa, but also a study permit (Study Permit). Simultaneously with the submission of its documents, you can request entry documents for the accompanying family members. Your spouse will be able to get a job permit in Canada, and children - permission for free studies in the Canadian school.

7. Moving to Canada.If you have successfully obtained all the necessary documents, then only pleasant troubles for moving to Canada remain.
